



Uplift Readiness Survey

Thank you to everyone who helped distribute and complete the Uplift Readiness Assessment! While there was slightly less engagement than our last time point, we had more First Responders complete the survey than ever before. We saw some minor changes in readiness across the board (some increases and some decreases). Mental Health Providers reported minor increases across all three readiness components, and First Responders reported a particular increase in general capacity. The data will be described in detail at the Quarterly Uplift meeting.

Uplift Partnership Transformation

“We’re getting the hang of this” and “this is who we are and how we do our work!” Uplift has moved beyond “not yet started” and “building a foundation” across all domains of the CTM, which was completed during the last Quarterly Uplift meeting.

The partnership sets goals to continue focusing on how we include people with lived experience and planning for sustainability. A new goal area was identified to focus more on measuring if a solution is making a difference.

SC Department of Mental Health

LCCMHC has a new Mental Health Professional coming on board on June 19th to work alongside our wonderful EMS community paramedics team.

Throughout this quarter, LCCMHC and EMS have met weekly to review referrals to Uplift and work together to support individuals receiving services from Uplift. We look forward to including our new therapist in this staffing. LCCMHC purchased a vehicle for our new Mental Health Professional to use to visit people in the community and provide services.
